
Reconciliation Week

Reconciliation Week is a time for all Australians to learn about our shared histories, cultures and achievements and to explore how each of us can contribute to achieving reconciliation in Australia. The theme for Reconciliation Week is '**Be a Voice For Generations.**' Last week eight Grade 5 and 6's attended a reconciliation event at the civic hall, where they were able to express what reconciliation means to them.

Attendance

The acceptable rate of absence for a semester is 0 - 6 days. We know there are many reasons why a child is not attending school and I wanted to communicate the reasons that are acceptable as well as the unacceptable reasons.

Below is our current data of the percentage of students in each year level that have had 10 or more days absent since the beginning of this year:



Overall, 39% of the students at Bundarra PS have been absent for 10 days or more this semester. If we compare this to all Victorian schools – 24%, you can see that we have a lot more students being absent. When you do not send your child to school, please consider if the reason is acceptable.

Acceptable Reason: Being sick, medical appointment, bereavement, religious and cultural observation and sorry business. Extended family holiday is an acceptable form of absence, however it requires my approval. For this reason, it is important if you are going on an extended holiday that you make an appointment with me. **Unacceptable Reason**: Birthday, sick or unwell family member, tired from the weekend, family visiting from out of town, stayed up late the night before and refusing to come to school.
