
Outside School Hours Care Grant

We are so excited to have obtained an Outside School Hours Care Grant - that we are hoping to begin at the start of term 1 next year! This will mean that we will be able to offer out of school care to families where their work hours don't always align with school hours. At the moment, this grant has been put out to tender and we are seeking organisations to run the program. We are also so lucky to have amazing facilities to support this program and have acquired funding to improve existing facilities. Watch this space – it is very exciting!

Attendance Data

Bundarra Primary School provides our students with engaging programs in learning and wellbeing that aim to provide the best education for your child/ren. However, if students are not at school to be exposed to this, it will be limited in its impact. While I acknowledge there has been a lot of sickness around at the moment that is taking a large amount of time to get over (explainable absences), sitting alongside that is a number of students who are missing school and we have not been able to get an explanation as to why this is (unexplainable absences). The data that you will see in this newsletter shows students that have missed 10 or more days of school this year. At best, this equates to one day off a fortnight. This does have a large impact on the learning these students can acquire. Here is a reminder of when it is **not OK** to be away: **Birthday**, **sick or** unwell family member, tired from the weekend, family visiting from out of town, stayed up late the night before and refusing to come to school.

Please note that you need to communicate to the school via Audiri App or phone call **every day your child is away**
