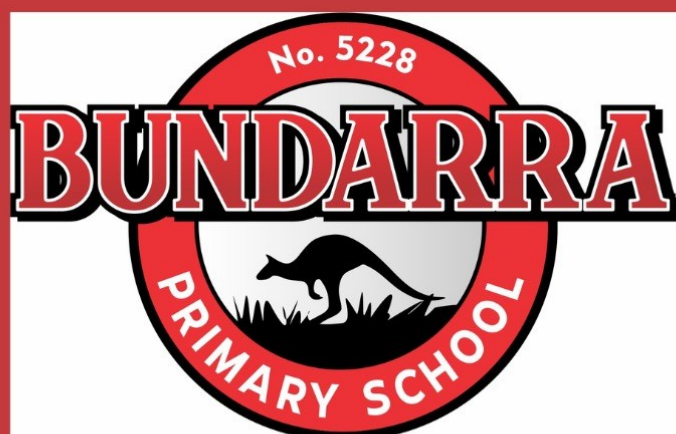
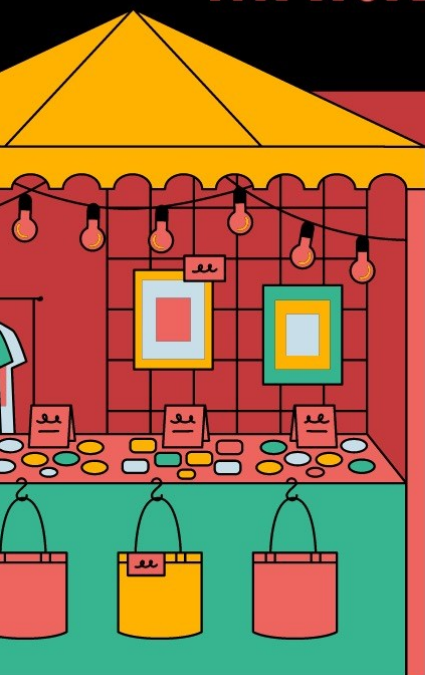

This term our Art Theme has been CASTLES. Students from all grades have been creating all things medieval including patchwork castles, banners made from old pillowcases and learning to dry felt as they create a sigil for their own kingdom. Please check it all out in the art corridor. The next couple of weeks will see students build their own great towers out of cardboard boxes; stock the armoury with swords, maces, staffs, battle-axes and shields. Students from grades 4 to 6 are making intricate 3D castles by layering 4 photos (Paper tole).



Hands On Learning

Each Monday learning takes place in the outdoors and the art room and kitchen as students tackle practical tasks that improve their problem solving skills, teamwork, collaboration and willingness to contribute to larger projects.

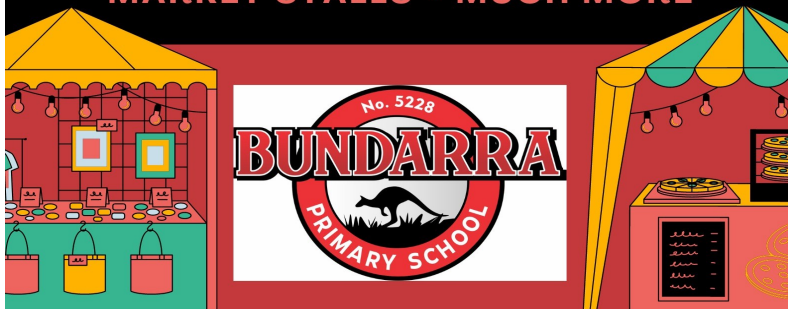
